

## winter excursions 2015/16

### **Salzburg** (full day)

incl. Guide & City-Tour

Monday 07.30 a.m. – 06.00 p.m.

We drive through the Inn Valley to Rattenberg, one of the oldest towns in Austria. During a break you can visit the famous glass factory Kissinger, which dates back to the middle Ages. We continue our trip through a lovely farming region onto Salzburg. A stop of approx. 3 ½ hours will give you ample time to do some shopping or sightseeing in the city. Salzburg is one of the most popular travel destinations in Austria, especially due to its connection to the life of Mozart! Together with your guide you will explore this beautiful town in a guided city walk of ¾ hours. You will visit the birthplace of Mozart, Salzburg cathedral and the famous Getreidegasse...

### **Venice** (full day)

We drive on the freeway from Innsbruck via Bolzano, Trento and Verona to Venice. Your tour guide takes you by boat to St. Mark's square and Doges Palace. The whole afternoon is free to explore Venice on your own or to do some shopping. Use the opportunity to take a gondola ride and visit one of the world famous Venetian glass workshops. Return to Innsbruck around 10.00 p.m.

### **Glacier Man & Vipiteno** (full day)

This scenic journey over the Brenner Pass into Italy gives you a taste of culture and spectacular landscape of the South Tyrol. Our main stop is Bolzano, where part of Tyrol's history came to life. Visit the old town of Bolzano and the famous archaeological museum, the home of "Ötzi" - the 5300 year old mummified "Ice Age man", found on the Similaun-glacier. Afterwards we carry on to the medieval border town of Vipiteno for a stop.

## Bavarian Royal Castles (full day)

Leaving Innsbruck, we drive through a beautiful region of the Tyrol before crossing the German border near Füssen. Just a few miles from the border you can see the castles of Hohenschwangau & Neuschwanstein - tour of Neuschwanstein Castle, one of King Ludwig's II most extraordinary fantasies (admission approx. € 12,- not incl.). Return to Innsbruck via Oberammergau (famous for its Passion plays and wood carvings), Ettal, Garmisch-Partenkirchen (Winter Olympics 1936) and Seefeld.

## Olympic Bobsled run (evening excursion)

You go by coach to the Olympic bob run in Igls on a plateau above Innsbruck. An experienced bob-pilot takes you down through the bobsled run in an original 4-seater bob. Discover exciting 1270 meters with 14 curves, a loop and a vertical drop of 124 meters. Each participant receives a certificate. Operates until end of February

## Winter Wonderland (evening excursion)

Enjoy a Horse-drawn sleigh ride! Our coach takes you along to Seefeld followed by a horse-drawn sleigh ride through the beautiful Tyrolean countryside. Stop at a cozy alpine inn – a glass of "Glühwein" (mulled wine) is included.

## St. Moritz (Switzerland) (full day)

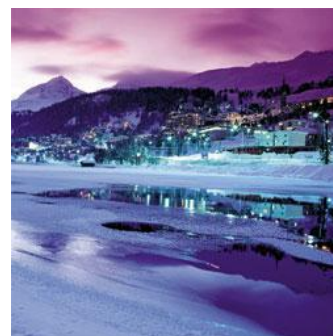
