



**TRIP INFORMATION**  
**STEAMBOAT RACE / SKI / RIDE CAMP**

**SIGN-UP:** All applicants must be a member of a Crescent Ski Council affiliated club **by Oct. 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017** to participate. Applicant's membership will be verified by CSC. Everyone must register directly with CSC's travel agent, **Sports America Tours** (SAT). All registrations must be completed online at [www.sportsamerica.com/csctrips](http://www.sportsamerica.com/csctrips). Assistance is provided by calling 800-876-8551 ext 125. If paying by check, **make payable to SAT.** (Payment must be received within 15 days of online registration).

**REGISTRATION PERIOD:** Registration begins **June 1, 2017** and ends **November 1, 2017, or when 400 participants are reached,** whichever occurs first. SAT will not accept any form of registration prior to, nor after this period.

**PACKAGE COST (VARIES):** **\$1090 is the "Early" rate, limited to 72 spaces.** Other rates/options are shown in the Table below.

**CSC/SAT reserves the right to assign unit type without regard to "Early" vs. "Regular" rate (does not apply to 1B/1B rate). Rate for "extra pillow" in Private Bedroom will be as listed in table below.**

## SKIING & SNOWBOARDING LEVELS - What Level are YOU?

		<b>SKIING</b>	<b>SNOW-BOARDING</b>
<b>Beginner</b>	<b>LEVEL 1</b>	You have never skied before.	<b>LEVEL 1</b> You have never snowboarded before.
	<b>LEVEL 2</b>	You have spent a few hours on the slope. Can ski in. a cautious wedge	<b>LEVEL 2</b> You can side slip on toe or heel, sliding to the left and to the right.
	<b>LEVEL 3</b>	You can make round wedge turns on gentle green terrain.	<b>LEVEL 3</b> You are beginning to complete a basic toe and heel turn on gentle green terrain.

<b>Intermediate</b>	<b>LEVEL 4</b>	You can link wedge turns with speed control and bring skis together parallel at the end of the turn on green and the easiest of blue runs.	<b>LEVEL 4</b> You are able to complete basic turns on toe and heel side that are connected with a traverse on green and the easiest blue runs
	<b>LEVEL 5</b>	You are confident on green and easy blue runs. You ski mostly parallel but may wedge or step to start the turns.	
	<b>LEVEL 6</b>	You use a parallel stance on smooth blue runs and would like to improve your parallel turn on more challenging terrain, including easy bumps and groomed black runs.	<b>LEVEL 5</b> You are able to link turns with rhythm and flow, with no traverse on either heel or toe side, on all blue and easy black runs
	<b>LEVEL 7</b>	You ski with controlled parallel turns, maintaining rhythm and speed control on groomed black runs.	
<b>Advanced</b>	<b>LEVEL 8</b>	You ski with good technique on most terrain and snow conditions, using carved short radius turns.	<b>LEVEL 6</b> You are able to comfortably link turns of various radius on most terrain and snow conditions, including the terrain park.
